## **Steward Qualification Committee (SQC)**

#### **Governing Policies**

All Sovrin Governing Bodies inherit the base set of policies defined in <u>Sovrin Governing Body</u> <u>Policies</u>, including chartering, membership, chairpersons, facilitators, subgroups, funding, voting, intellectual property rights, meetings, and meeting pages. This charter defines extensions to these policies specific to this Sovrin Governing Body.

#### **Status**

This Sovrin Governing Body is organized as a **committee** as defined in <u>Sovrin Governing Body</u> *Policies*.

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of the Steward Qualification Committee (SQC) is to review applications and make recommendations to the Board of Trustees about an organization's qualifications for Sovrin Stewardship.



## **Principles**

All Sovrin Governing Bodies operate under the Core Principles in section 2 of the <u>Sovrin Governance Framework V2</u>. These principles, especially Decentralization by Design, are of particular importance in determining the qualifications and governing the process for approving Sovrin Stewards.

#### **Activities and Duties**

- The SQC is responsible for maintaining the Controlled Document entitled <u>Sovrin Steward</u> <u>Business Policies</u> that defines the policies and procedures by which organizations proceed through the stages of Sovrin Stewardship:
  - a. Application.
  - b. Qualification.
  - c. Activation.
  - d. Operation.
  - e. Suspension.
  - f. Termination.
- 2. The SQC shall oversee and make recommendations about the Sovrin Foundation's implementation of these policies and procedures.
- The SQC shall make recommendations to the Sovrin Board of Trustees (BoT) as to whether a specific organization should be approved, suspended, or terminated as a Sovrin Steward.

#### Membership

- 1. Members are appointed by the Sovrin BoT.
- 2. The SQC shall consist of six members.
  - a. Four members of the BoT.
  - b. Two members of the Sovrin Technical Governance Board (TGB).
- 3. Members shall serve one-year terms, except for the initial members: two members of the BoT and one member of the TGB shall serve two-year terms.

## Chairperson(s)

The SQC shall have one chairperson.



### Facilitator(s)

A member of the Sovrin Foundation staff shall serve as facilitator.

## Voting

All Sovrin Governing Bodies shall strive to reach decisions by consensus. When necessary, voting will be conducted as specified in <u>Sovrin Governing Body Policies</u>.

## **Funding**

The SQC may seek funding for consultation with outside experts as required to fulfill its duties. Such funding requests must be approved by the Executive Director of the Sovrin Foundation.

#### **Meeting Schedule**

The SQC shall hold virtual meetings monthly on a day and time determined by consensus or a vote of the members and recorded on the meeting page.

#### **Meeting Page**

All Sovrin Governing Bodies are required to maintain a meeting page with full information about the group, current documents, and how to participate in meetings. Follow this link to the <u>SQC</u> meeting page.
